

## Role Play Questions

- 1) Are Mormons Christian? You guys don't believe in the Trinity right?
- 2) How do you know they are 3 separate beings?
- 3) Do you believe that they are all Spirits?
- 4) What does your church believe is the purpose of God, Jesus and the Holy Ghost?

## Possible answers to Role Plays

- 1) The LDS Church's first Article of Faith is "We believe in God, the Eternal Father, and in His Son, Jesus Christ, and in the Holy Ghost." This is a straightforward statement of belief that there are three members in the Godhead. We are definitely Christians but we believe all 3 beings are individuals.
  
- 2) We believe that the record of Jesus' baptism in Matthew shows all three beings identified as different people. Jesus is being baptized, Heavenly Father speaks from Heaven and the Holy Ghost descends as a dove. Also, Joseph Smith had a vision where he sees God the Father and Jesus standing side by side. Stephen also had this vision as described in Acts.
  
- 3) We believe that Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ have bodies of flesh and bone but that the Holy Ghost is a Spirit personage. (D&C 130:22)
  
- 4) We believe that they are 3 separate beings but they all have one purpose, which is to help all of us gain eternal life. (Moses 1:39)
