

You can write these statements on a post it note, or print this and put tape on the back.

Have a Young Woman come to the front of the room. Walk around her making these statements and sticking the notes to her. (her head, her arms, her back etc. ☺) Really try to play it up so they feel the impact of their words.

The point of this object lesson is to show the girls that the statements they make can and will influence others. They "Stick!"

### NEGATIVE STATEMENTS

She's "INACTIVE!"

She's a "NON-MEMBER"

"I wouldn't ask her to speak in sacrament, she doesn't come very often."

"I'm pretty sure she won't come to the activity, don't give her an assignment."

"Who knows where she lives?"

"I don't think her family even comes!"

### POSITIVE STATEMENTS

"She seems really nice, I'm excited to get to know her better."

"I think she moved in close to me. I'll go over and find out."

"I think she'd give a great talk, ask her if she'd like to!"

"I'm going to give her a ride to the activity tonight."

"She is really strong. She comes by herself. I'm going to ask her to sit with me and my family."
